2. Judging Commences: Friday 25 September at 10:00 am.
3. All exhibits are to be brought in from 7.00 am and BEFORE 9:00 am.
4. Entries can be picked up from the Pavilion from Sunday 27 September between 9.00 am –10.00 am.
5. The same Exhibit cannot be entered in two classes in this section.
6. Container shall mean three or more stems.
7. NND means not necessarily distinct.
8. No award will be made in Championships, if in the opinion of the Judge, the Exhibit is not of Championship standard.
9. Champions chosen from Exhibits tabled.
10. Distinct means different.
11. You must have your entries ready to present, specific container included.

DEFINITION OF CONTAINERS

VASE: Taller than it is wide.

BOWL: Broader than it is tall.

BASKET: A flower basket with large handle.

TROUGH: An oblong container.

FLOAT BOWL: A flat vessel in which the flower or flowers and or foliage must float in water.
