RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Entries close: **Friday 18 September at 10.00 am.**
2. Judging Commences: Saturday 26 September at 10.30 am.
3. Nomination fees are \$1 for Members and \$3 for Non-Members.
4. Kyogle P A and H Society Incorporated is known as Kyogle Show.
5. Late entries in any section will not be accepted.
6. No cattle on the grounds until after **1:30 pm on Friday 25 September.**
7. All exhibitors and competitors compete entirely at their own risk and Kyogle Show is not responsible for any injury, damage or loss sustained by an exhibitor or competitor.
8. Changes to the program and regulations can be made at the discretion of the Chief Steward on the day.
9. All cattle to be on the grounds by **9.00 am on the day of the show** and remain until after the Grand Parade. Prize winning animals should participate in the Grand Parade.
10. All cattle on the grounds should be secured at all times.
11. Only 1st prize animals can compete for Champion. The animal placed 2nd in the Class can compete for Reserve Champion.
12. If any doubts arise in the mind of the Judge in any class, the matter will be referred to the Chief Steward for clarification.
13. All exhibits must be registered with a recognised breed society and must be entered by the registered owner and exhibited as per the breed society regulations.
14. Age is classified as at the 1 June 2026.
15. All exhibits in pen and group classes must have been entered in single classes.
16. Substitutions to entries can be made up to the day before judging.
17. All cattle must be made available for inspection to persons nominated by Kyogle Show or Breed Society
18. Registration certificates to be available for each exhibit on the day.
19. All persons leading exhibits in the Judging Ring must be suitably attired.
20. Kyogle Show will not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss or any damage thereto of livestock at the Society's Exhibition.
21. No milk is to be disposed of on grounds.
22. Exhibitors to provide their own water troughs.
23. No pestivirus testing is required, JDDS score of 4 is required.
24. All Champions receive \$50 and Reserve Champions \$30 to be collected from Show Office on the day.

Class 1318	Exhibitors group. Comprised of 2 animals over 3 years and 2 animals under 3 years

YOUNG PARADERS

Age of handler to be calculated as on the day of the show.

Class 1319	Fancy Dress- best dressed child and/or calf, open to all competitors in the junior handler classes
Class 1320	Under 5 years of age assisted handler, child to be accompanied by an adult Entrant is not eligible to compete for the champion handler
Class 1321	Handler Under 7 years of age.
Class 1322	Handler 7 years and under 10 years
Class 1323	Handler 10 years and under 14 years
Class 1324	Handler 14 years and under 18 years
Class 1325	Handler 18 years and under 25 years
Class 1326	Best prepared and presented. To be judged for overall presentation of the heifer and the handler
