RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Entries close: **Friday 18 September at 9.00 am**
2. ALL ENTRY FEES ARE FREE.
3. Each Class will be awarded, 1st, 2nd and 3rd card and ribbon.
4. Each Section will be awarded 1st, \$10 and 2nd \$5 with the most points.
5. The Most Successful Exhibitor, Champion \$30 and Reserve Champion \$20.
6. The point score will be as follows, 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point.
7. Judging Commences: Friday 25 September at 10:00 am.
8. All exhibits are to be brought in BEFORE 9:00 am.
9. Entries can be picked up from the Pavilions from Sunday 27 September between 9.00 am –10.00 am
10. ONLY OPEN TO CURRENT RURAL YOUTH CLUB (RY) MEMBERS.
11. All work must be completed within the last three (3) years except for Photography, which must have been taken in the last 12 months. Entries previously entered will not be judged.
12. Photography must be mounted on black card, 4"x6" not to exceed A5. Limited to 3 entries per class.
13. All produce must have been grown by the RY member.
14. RY Members 12 years and under are eligible to enter Open classes.
15. Beef Cattle rules of entry, see Beef Cattle Saturday program, must enter the same in those classes.
16. Poultry rules of entry are the same as any other class in the Poultry program.
17. RY members must sign an Indemnity Waiver for any section.
