RULES OF ENTRY / REGULATIONS:

1. All entrants must read and complete the attached entry form prior to entry into the Kyogle Show Young Woman Competition, with additional forms to be completed by the winner prior to entry into Zone Finals.
2. Entry form must be received by the Steward or Show Secretary no later than 5.00 pm on Monday 17 August 2026.
3. Please email to secretary@kyogleshow.com.au.
4. Judging will take place on Saturday 29 August 2026, which includes an interview and a dinner at Kyogle Bowling Club.
5. Announcement of winner will take place at the Opening Ceremony of the 2026 Kyogle Show.
6. The winner will represent Kyogle at the Zone 1 Final hosted by Wauchope Show Society - 30 January 2027.
7. The winner will participate in formalities at the 2026 Kyogle Show including the Opening Ceremony.
8. The winner will receive membership to the Kyogle Show Society for one (1) year and a range of additional prizes, including attendance at a Personal Development Weekend usually held in Dubbo, dates to be advised (usually November or January).
9. Any queries regarding eligibility should be referred to the Sydney Royal AgShows NSW Young Woman Competition Coordinator of the Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales or, the Sydney Royal AgShows NSW Young Woman Competition Delegate of the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW.
10. The Competition is only open to permanent residents of Australia.
11. Entrants must be women aged from 18 years to under 26 years as at 1st May 2027.
12. Entrants must reside, be educated or work within New South Wales for at least three months prior to their local YWA Competition to qualify to compete within the State.
13. Only candidates nominated by an Agricultural Show Society are eligible for Zone and State Final Judging.
14. Previous entrants in the YWA Competition are eligible to enter; however, they are not to have been one of the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place getters in a previous State Final.
15. The following people are not eligible to enter the YWA Competition:
 - (a) Staff, Delegates and Councillors of both the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW ("RAS") and the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW ("ASC").
 - (b) The daughters of the Staff, Delegates and Councillors of the RAS and ASC.
16. Winning entrants who are employed or engaged in full time studies will be required to obtain a leave of absence to attend Zone and State Final Judging.
